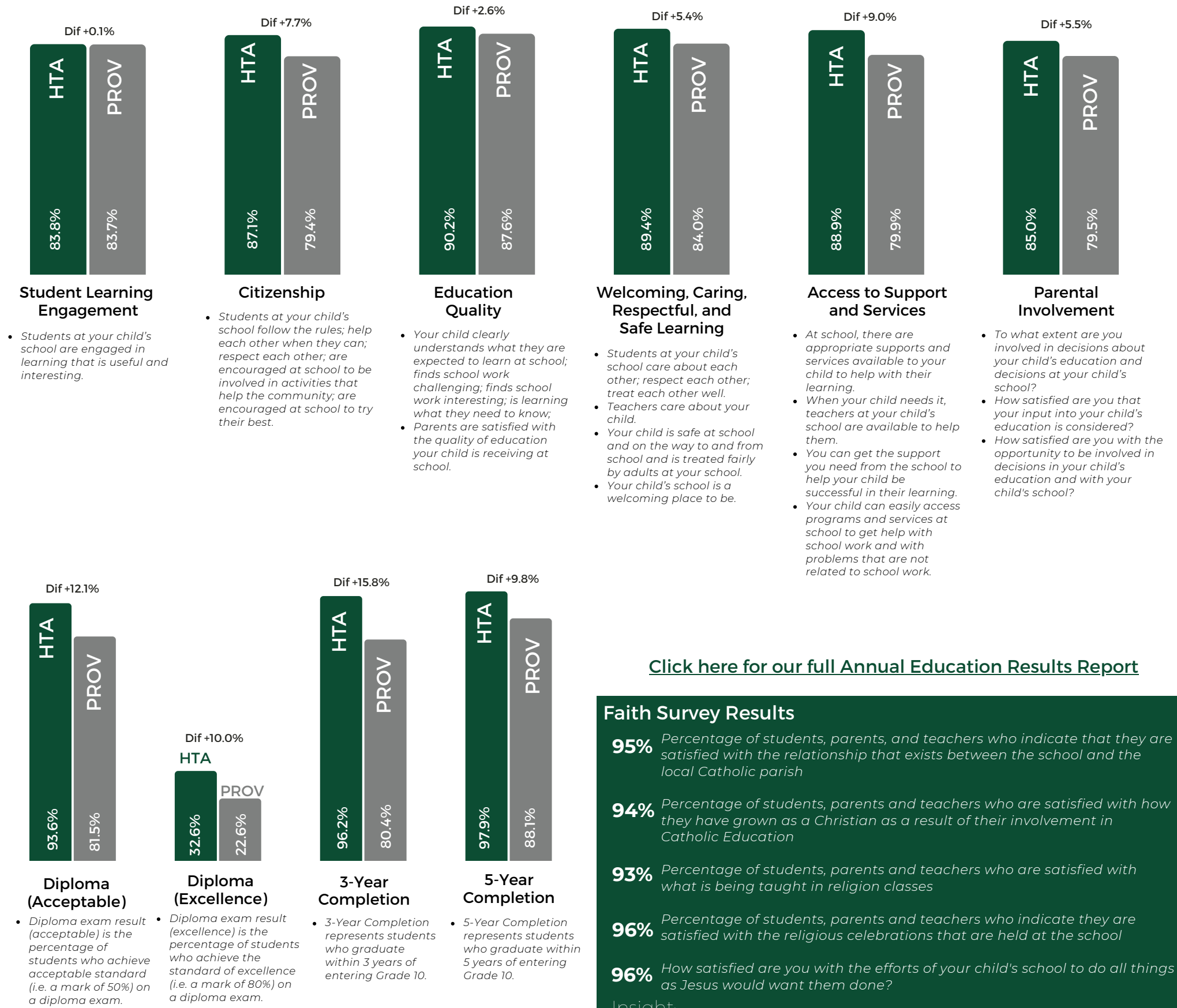




ALBERTA ASSURANCE ANNUAL EDUCATION RESULTS

Faith Survey Results

- 95%

Percentage of students, parents, and teachers who indicate that they are satisfied with the relationship that exists between the school and the local Catholic parish
- 94%

Percentage of students, parents and teachers who are satisfied with how they have grown as a Christian as a result of their involvement in Catholic Education
- 93%

Percentage of students, parents and teachers who are satisfied with what is being taught in religion classes

Insight:
We are proud of the high satisfaction rates in the area of Faith, most especially the satisfaction rates of 96% of parents, students, and teachers who are satisfied with the religious celebrations held at the school and that the school is doing all things as Jesus would want them done.

Insights:

- Exemplary High School Completion Rates: 96.2% of our students graduate within 3 years, which is 15.5% higher than the graduation rates in the province.
- Exemplary Diploma Results: 93.6% of our students attained the Acceptable standard on their diploma exams, which is 12.1% above the province, and 32.6% attained the standard of Excellence, which is 10% above the province.
- Exemplary Active Citizenship by our students: 87.1% of our parents, teachers, and students are satisfied that students model the characteristics of active citizenship, which is 7.7% above the provincial average. The provincial results in this area have steadily declined over the last three years, whereas HTA's results have been continuously improving.
